A "cookie" is a text file that a website sends to your computer or other device connected to the Internet in order to uniquely identify the user's browser or to save information or settings in your browser.

By closing the banner you see while browsing the site, scrolling through any page in the site, or clicking on any of its elements, you agree to their use. This site uses "technical" and/or "profiling" cookies.

Technical cookies

- cookies related to tasks that are strictly necessary for the operation and delivery of the service;
- cookies related to the saving and optimization of preferences (e.g. Flash Player cookies if they don't exceed the duration of the session, cookies for saving the shopping cart or preferences in language/currency);
- statistical cookies, where they are used directly by the site operator to collect information in aggregate form.

Profiling cookies

- first or third party advertising profiling cookies;
- retargeting cookies;
- social networking cookies;
- statistical cookies fully managed by third parties.
